The National Pan-Hellenic Council of Cobb County (CNPHC) was chartered in 2013 to serve Cobb County and its surrounding areas. The CNPHC promotes community interaction through forums, meetings and other mediums for the exchange of information and engages in cooperative programming and initiatives through various activities and functions.

The National Pan-Hellenic Council of Cobb County understands its responsibility and obligation to make sure that the young men and women in our communities have the same opportunities to further their education and excel past the generation that came before them. The CNPHC shows its appreciation for the experiences bestowed on its members as college graduates by giving the same opportunities to the next generation. These contributions aid deserving students in reaching their educational goals.

The CNPHC is providing scholarships to deserving African-American students in the following categories:

- Scholarships will be awarded to 2022 graduating seniors attending high school in Cobb County.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must have demonstrated leadership ability in the school and community.
- Applicants must have participated in community service projects.

In order to be considered for a scholarship, the following items must be included with the application:

- Completed Scholarship Application
- One (1) (High School) transcript including grades for the current year (it can be sent via email)
- 500-word essay, double-spaced and typed

Essay topic: Unemployment – The African American unemployment rate generally doubles that of the population as a whole, demonstrating pronounced difficulties providing for our families and accumulating wealth. If you could offer a solution or program to educate on the importance and value of wealth accumulation, where would you start and what would it look like?

- Two (2) letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, employer or volunteer organization on official letterhead (typed & signed via email)

Completed applications are due by May 13, 2022 by 11:59PM:

1. Scan and send one (1) email including completed application, 500-word essay and an unofficial transcript to the scholarship committee at cnphcscholarship@gmail.com (partial submissions will not be accepted).
2. Letters of recommendation must be emailed to the scholarship committee from the person who is recommending the applicant (make sure the recommender puts your name in the subject line of the email).

Missing any of the above documents will result in an incomplete package and will not be considered for an award
